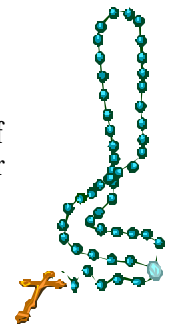

If you can volunteer, please be sure to go see Coach Martin and Coach Porter as soon as possible.

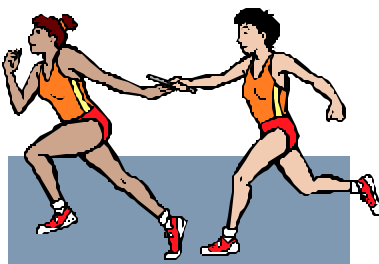
