BIRDIES FOR BRICKS CROSS

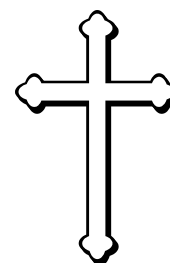

 - E. Uses talents in service to family, school, Church, and community.

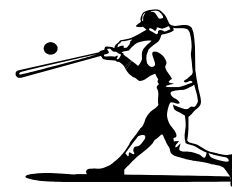
PRAYER REQUESTS
