

8th Grade Supply List

For Home Use (must be available at home for school use: to be kept at home)

- Internet access for homework and projects; a working dependable printer
- Stapler (please keep replenished with staples)
- Scotch tape (please keep replenished with tape)
- Bible
- 1 - T1-30X II Scientific Calculator
- 1 - Thesaurus
- 1 - Spanish/English Dictionary (**to be kept at home**)
- 1 - English Dictionary
- 1 - Protractor
- 1 - Compass
- 1 - Pair of scissors
- Pencils, markers, crayons, etc...
- 1 - Ruler with inches and centimeters
- 500 pieces white college-ruled binder paper
- 400 pieces 4 x 4 (1/4 inch) graph paper (some science and all math homework is completed on graph paper)
- 17 - Pocket Accordion folder
- 10 -brown bag paper bags from the grocery store to cover school books (taller bags are preferable)

For School Use

- 1 - Small pencil pouch/bag to carry from class to class, and sized to carry *only* memory stick, 2 highlighters, 2 pencils, 2 blue pens, 2 black pens, 1 red pen, 1 green pen and 2 Dry Erase pens
- 2 - Mechanical pencils with enough erasers and replacement lead to last the entire school year (keep extra erasers and lead at home)
- 1 - Memory stick
- 2 - Red ballpoint pens (non-clickable type)
- 2 - Green ballpoint pens (non-clickable type)
- 12 - Blue or black ballpoint pens (non-clickable type)
Bring 2 to school; keep extras at home until needed
- 2 - Fine tip (dark colors) Dry-Erase markers (math)
- 2 - Highlighter (yellow and one other color)
- 1 - Planner for school year

For School Use (to be brought to school and left at school in classroom)

- 1 - Spanish/English dictionary (can be electronic dictionary) to be left at school: **DO NOT TAKE HOME**
- 1 - Fine point black Sharpie marker
- 1 - Ultra fine point Sharpie black marker
- 1 - Box of crayons (16-20 color box **MAX**)
- 1 - Set sharpened colored pencils (16 color set **MAX**)
- 1 - Set fine tip colored markers (16-20 color set **MAX**)
- 1 - Pair scissors
- 1 - Large Elmer's glue stick
- 1 - bottle Elmer's glue (8oz)
- 5 - White poster boards (science and history - **NO FOAM BOARDS OR TRI-FOLDS**)
- 3 - 2 pocket folders (homework, history, language arts)
- 2 - 2 inch 3 ring binders (2 inch only) (history,/language arts and math/science)
- 2 - 1 Subject Spiral notebook with pockets (religion and Spanish)

For School Use (to be brought to school and left at school in the classroom)

- 2 - 3 Subject Spiral Notebooks with pockets (history, language arts) (these should be 3 holed punched to fit into binder)
- 2 - College ruled 100 page composition books (religion, literature) (9 1/4" x 7 1/2") (black/white cover)
- 1 - 1/4" quad graph paper 100 page composition books (science) (9 1/4" x 7 1/2") (black/white cover)
- 2 - Packages of white 4" x 6" index cards (100 count) (history and language arts)
- 2 - Sets of 5 plastic binder divider tabs/sleeves with pockets (10 total binder divider tabs/sleeves for math/science)
- 1 - Ream colored photocopy paper (500 count; light pastel colors are preferred: yellow, blue, green, pink, etc...)
- 2 - Reams of white photocopy paper
- 3 - Rolls of paper towels
- 1 - Antibacterial gel or 2 liquid hand soaps (liquid pump style)
- 3 - Boxes of facial tissues (Scotties, Kleenex, etc...)
- 1 - Box quart-size Ziploc Bags
